Let's Begin with the Letter People!

The Letter People is a research-based program for early literacy, organized around themes that integrate knowledge across the subject areas of oral language, listening, and cognitive, physical and social learning. The sequence in which the Letter People are introduced follows the sequence in which speech sounds are typically acquired, so they will not be introduced in a typical A-Z pattern. Students will still gain letter recognition and knowledge, on top of many other concepts, as we introduce each different Letter Person throughout the year.

We also supplement the Letter People with a Math and Science component from Abrams and Co. as well as the Adventures in Learning Curriculum published by the Arkansas Department of Human Services - Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Education. Other supplemental curriculums that we use are: PreK Everyday Math which aligns with district Math curriculum. We also use a program called Second Step to add a social/emotional piece to our curriculum.
